Dear FBCH Family,

It is an exciting time as people begin to get their vaccinations and we see a little bit of light beginning to peak through the crack in the opening doorway! As a church made up of children of God, with the purpose of worshiping and serving our Lord Jesus, our mission remains the same no matter what is going on out there in this upside-down world we find ourselves in:
