Dear FBCH Family,

Spring has sprung, and while the March and April weather are notorious for both sunshine and storms, new life is beginning to bud and sprout all around us. It's time to make sure there is air in your lawnmower tires, a spool of trim strong in your weed-eater, and that your gardening gloves are dusted off and ready to be put on for work!

We're also seeing signs of change when it comes to this unprecedented quarantine period. People are getting vaccinated. COVID cases are falling. COVID treatments are improving. People are feeling more and more safe venturing back out into the world. As one pastor reportedly remarked,

"We have spent an entire year tending to your physical health."

Now we need to return to your spiritual health."

As your situation changes, now is the time to seriously begin asking, "When should I go back to in-person worship?" Every person's situation is unique and different, and I can't answer it for you. But you need to ask yourself that question and think about what would signal that homecoming for you. As Christians, we recognize that spiritual health is at least as important as physical health, and we've seen the neglect of spiritual health leading to all manner of emotional health problems, violence, and more in the world around us. God-ordained Christian fellowship and times of worship are a critical part of our walks with the Lord—times that are important for us to be grown as His people, to be re-energized, to study and learn more about Him and living for Him, and to be a part of building up other brothers and sisters in the Lord ourselves. We are all called to be a living part of His church, and His church should be a living and breathing part of our lives as well.

We have been so blessed to have online options available that are wonderful tools for outreach and sharing God's message, especially during this time of quarantines. It is obviously more convenient to watch a service from the comfort of your own home, in pajamas, with a cup of hot coffee in your hands and a warm and adoring dog at your feet. It will always be more convenient to watch a service online...but it will never be a better option than worshiping together with other believers in person. We need that fellowship. God built us for relationship with Him and with each other. God ordained our Christian community. We need each other. And the Lord already holds us all in the palm of His hand...

For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Romans 8:38-39)

What can you do during this time of transition? Please pray that we as a church family can begin to refocus on our flock's spiritual health in addition to our physical health as vaccinations increase and people's apprehensiveness declines. For the sake of fellowship, pray that people would begin returning to in-person worship so that we may bless and encourage them...and be blessed and encouraged by them! Much of this battle will be fought on our knees, but it can also be fought on our cell phones, computers, and through the mail! Reach out to someone you haven't seen in a while and let them know they are missed and loved and that we hope to see them again here soon. God has blessed us with this church family, for this particular time and place in history, and we can only function up to the full potential He has planned for us when each of us is in place as the building block we were designed to be—supporting others, being supported by others, and building up the church body for the ministry and mission to the community He intended for us.

You are missed. You are loved. You are needed. And your FBCH family is looking forward to seeing you again soon!

Apr. 4 - Pinto beans & Cornbread mix


Apr. 11 - Soups & crackers






