### From the Pastor's Pen...

Dear FBCH family,

Another year has passed; a new year is upon us. Will it be just another year, time marching on and marked off day by day, week by week, month by month...only to go through the same motion again the following year?

#### Why not make this year different?

Challenge yourself to make the most out of this year. Decide that you are going to live out your identity this year. What is your identity? Are you a Christian? (Joshua 5:12)




