### Points to Ponder



#### A DEVOTIONAL WORD...

The story I would like to share with you today is one of faith. Not too long ago I had an experience that strengthened my faith. I found myself in a difficult situation that I could not find a solution to, so I prayed to God for help and he answered my prayer.

"But when you ask, you must believe, because the one who doubts is like a wave on the sea, blown and tossed about. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord." (James 1:6-7)

My story begins at my home in North Carolina a few years ago. It was a Saturday morning and my task for the day was to mow the lawn. When I walked out into our rather large garage I noticed that a hummingbird had gotten trapped inside and was desperately flying around trying to escape. I opened the garage doors thinking he would just fly out but this seemed to alarm him even more. I could see that he was getting more and more desperate and weak, it appeared that if he kept on like he was he would fall to the ground and die. I felt like my heart was being wrenched from my chest, I could not allow anything to happen to this tiny little friend.

Let me take a minute to explain my passion for hummingbirds. My youth was filled with turmoil and strife at home, so like many other children that grow up this way I created sanctuaries that I could go to in times of trouble. My greatest sanctuary was to think of my grandmother. She was the most benevolent and holy person I have ever met, even to this day. She was an avid bird watcher and had a special place in her heart for hummingbirds. I will never forget her look of joy when one would come to her feeders; she seemed to transform from an elderly lady to a laughing little girl.

Back to my story, the more I tried to direct the hummingbird to the open garage door, the worse the situation seemed to get. I noticed that he would land briefly on the garage door motor, so I got a fishing net and hoisted it up to make a perch for him, but he would not come near me. It appeared that my presence was alarming to him even when stationary. At this point I was full of despair and was starting to lose hope.

While standing on the ladder with my net in the air I bowed my head and prayed to God for help. I put all of my heart into it and very quickly became overwhelmed with emotion. Looking back I realize now that I was not only praying for my little friend. I was also praying for my grandmother who had passed. For me that little bird represented all of the goodness in the world.

When I opened my eyes and blinked away my tears I looked up at the net I was grasping to behold the little hummingbird perched on the rim. My joy at seeing the bird perched on the net was quickly dashed when I realized that now I must take three steps down the ladder and at least ten steps to the open door. I closed my eyes again and a peace came over me that I would not know how to put into words. Along with the peace came a sense of purpose, so I stepped down off the ladder and walked to the door while he rode with me the whole way, perched up on that net. As I released my little friend up into the sky, I believe that the peace that filled my heart touched his as well.


So ends this story of faith. Although years have passed, I still think about what happened to me in that garage in North Carolina now and again and it always strengthens my faith. I pray that it will strengthen yours as well, but most of all, I pray that it will help you in finding your hummingbird.






