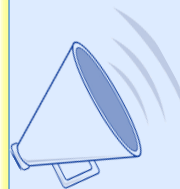

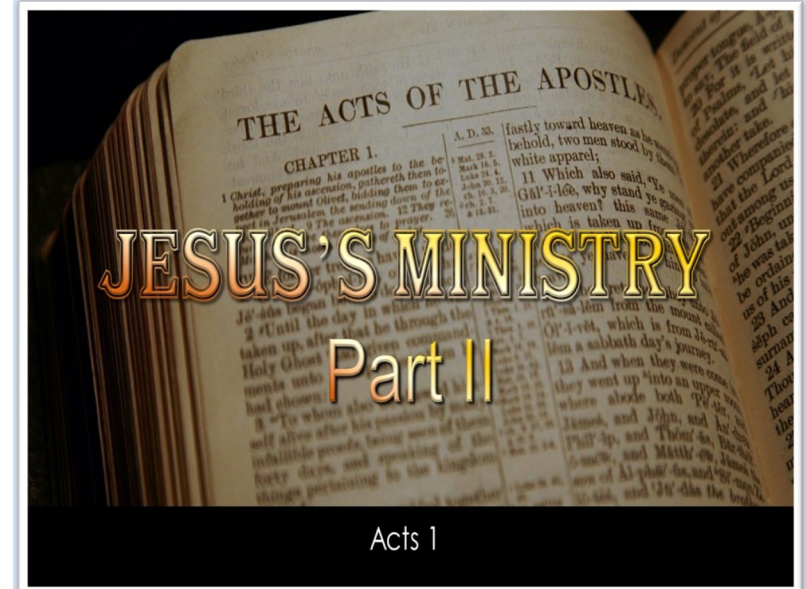

## EVENTS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

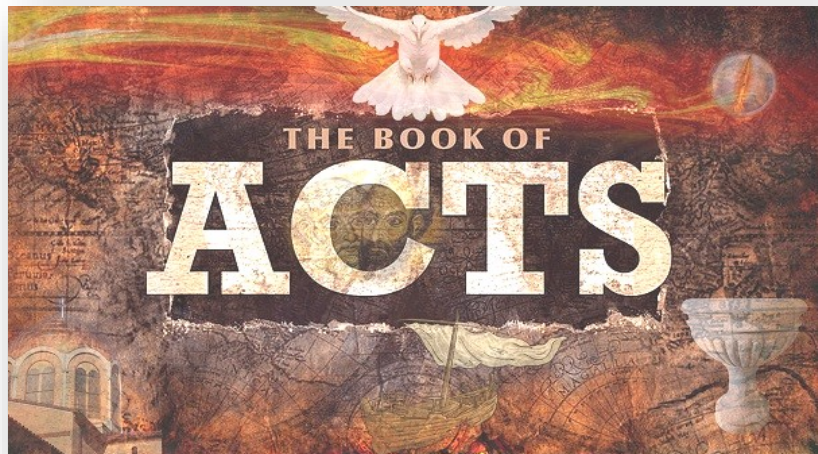
