These are examples only; there are several other ways to be active that the committee will consider. An applicant cannot have received an FBCH scholarship previously. Academic performance, FBCH ministry/mission involvement, and your stated personal relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ will be considered by the scholarship committee in determining awards.

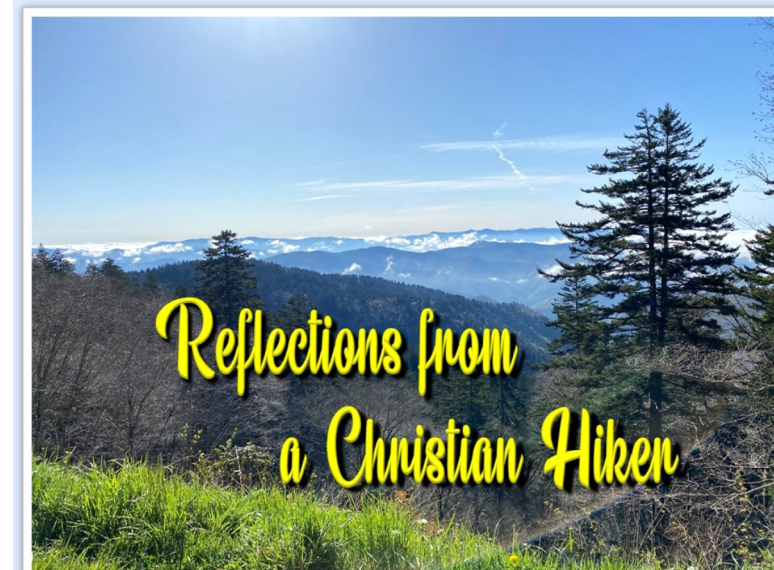
