POINTS TO PONDER



Taking Refuge

"Preserve me, O God, for in you I take refuge." (Psalm 16:1)

In Psalm 16, David begins to pour out his soul by pleading for preservation while he takes refuge in the secure fortress of his God. What is fascinating is that the focus of the psalmist is not to avoid any storm or attack that will come, but instead to have a preserving fortress to withstand what comes. There is wisdom in David's plea as he both shelters himself in God and acknowledges that the attacks will come.

We as followers of Jesus know it to be true that He is our strength and hope in this world. However, we often let the threat of danger chase us into a fog so dense we cannot see which way to go. We cry out for help and complain because the confidence we had has somehow disappeared. Like David in Psalm 42, we ask God "why have you forgotten me". But He hasn't moved. Nor has He forgotten us. He is faithful and never leaves us to fight on our own. He is right there fellow Christian. The fortress is still beckoning the redeemed of God to rest in the finished work of Jesus.

Yes, there are many things that come to darken the skies above us. It's not wrong to see the storm, feel the rain, hear the thunder, and run for shelter. What matters is the shelter you seek. Through prayer, God's Word, and regular fellowship with other believers we tether ourselves to the cross. We stand on the promises of our King "when the howling storms of doubt and fear assail. By the living word of God, we shall prevail." So let us resolve to make our home in our Savior as He, though dwelling in glory, made a home with us. Safe, secure, forevermore.

If you have been graciously made alive in Christ, you are now taking refuge in Him. Even the moments of doubt and weakness we have are covered by the blood of Jesus. Because of Calvary's cross, you are now a co-heir with Christ, and you are hidden in Him.

"You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fulness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." (Psalm 16:11)

CHURCH UPDATES




