"Pursuing His Glory"

Dear FBCH Family,

What a busy and wonderful month we had in March. We were able to look at 5 scenes from Easter and see the path to Christ's resurrection together. We are forever grateful for all that Easter represents and the salvation offered to us in Christ!

As we now look forward to April, let us shift our attention to what the response to Easter should be. Because of Christ's resurrection and the hope, we have we can now share with others the blessed good news that we have received. How?

First, be always ready to share with others the message of the gospel. As Romans 10:14 says, "How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?" Preaching may be something a pastor does in a pulpit, but when it comes to the message of the gospel, we are all preachers to someone. By that, I mean we all have a responsibility to tell others of the hope that lives inside of us. Be ready to share of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus with those around you.

Second, invite others into your life and our church. This is a high calling that can be both joyous and difficult. Inviting someone into your life means that you share more than just the minimum with them. You share burdens and concerns, ups and downs, and good and bad times with them. Walk with people in life and love them like Jesus. And when you do this, you have an opportunity to invite these people to join in worship with you. Let them know about the service times and ministries here at FBCH. If they have a home church, invite them to special events for fellowship. If they don't have a home church, let them know that this church wants to share life with them and pour into their spiritual life as they grew in the knowledge of our Lord.

Lastly, prepare for those who have yet to come to church. There is work to be done now to prepare for the people God will send to our church for His glory. Practice regularly welcoming the visitors who come to share with us. Follow up with them and let them see your hospitality as you want them to feel loved by the presence of God's people. Remember, when we gather each week, we are partaking in a gathering that is a taste of what is to come in glory. We gather to worship our God weekly and one day we will gather forever to worship Christ with all the saints, past, present, and future. While we mention that, I encourage you not to forsake the assembly here at church. We understand life happens and sickness is common. But we need to gather as often as we can to give worship to our Lord. You need it, your church needs it, and your God is worthy of it. Be here and worship together!

We praise God for all this, and we are prayerfully anticipating many blessings from the Lord!




FELLOWSHIP & CONNECTIONS
